PURPOSE

- **To ensure that all food consumed by IPPs are handled in accordance with the prescribed rules of hygiene and safety, in order to prevent foodborne illnesses.**



INTERNATIONALLY PROTECTED PERSONS (IPPs)

- **Representatives of a foreign State**
- **Members of the Royal Family**
- **Officials of an international organization**
- **Level of security assigned by the RCMP**
- **Their immediate family members accompanying them**



ACTIVITIES BEFORE THE SUMMITS

- **Designation of a laboratory for food and water analysis**
- **Development of a guide for food handlers**

- **Specific/Special Food Request by the Delegation**

- 24 hour/day surveillance

FOOD SURVEILLANCE DURING THE SUMMITS

- **30 Inspectors in Toronto**
- **8 Inspectors in Huntsville**
- **Laboratory On-Call 24 hrs**
- **5 Back-up Personnel**
